- Clear deadline
- Same documents for all candidates:
 - Criteria to fulfil
 - Proposal:
 - 1) objectives, actions, milestones and expected outcomes
 - 2) human resources, budget spending plan
- Supporting MS = pilot proposal
- MS with partner/single
- Support provided to candidates for building up proposal



- Submission to ACCORD consortium for selection




